VHI Cardiac Care Report Shows Decrease in Open Heart Surgeries, Increase in Medical and Invasive Cardiology Care



Richmond, VA – Virginia Health Information (VHI) publishes its Cardiac Care Report, including data on mortality and readmission rates from Virginia's acute hospitals. Offered as a free, online, searchable tool, the Cardiac Care Report can be valuable for patients and caregivers seeking information about their heart care options prior to an emergency or planned medical procedure. The report shows a decrease in open heart surgeries, but an increase in medical and invasive cardiology care. Data also shows that 71% of open heart surgery patients were males and roughly 64% of patients were between the ages of 60-79. The report, published annually during American Heart Month, is now available at <u>www.vhi.org/cardiac</u>.
